During the PL-2 and/or PL-3 years senior residents will partake of an international Humanitarian Assistance rotation to include a maximum of 4 weeks in Honduras or on a shipboard mission or a combination of the two, depending on ship's sailing schedules.

Adult ED, Orthopedics and OB/Gyn are required of all Navy interns. Air Force interns will have an elective block in place of OB/Gyn.

Call Frequency:

Inpatient: 2 calls per week (every 3.5 nights) for 8 calls per block
Applies to Ward, NICU, PICU, NSY rotations
Outpatient: average 4-5 calls per block or 1-1.25 nights per week
